

EASTPORT HISTORIC REVIEW BOARD
MINUTES OF APRIL 15, 2010 MEETING
AT SHEAD HIGH SCHOOL

Present: Board members Edward French, Jean Schild, John Melby, Wayne Wilcox and Russ Terry; others, Hugh French.

Minutes of the January 14, 2010, meeting were approved. Minutes from the meeting prior to that cannot be found.

Consideration of a Certificate of Appropriateness for a sign at the Tides Institute. Hugh French presented; Edward French recused himself; Russ Terry assumed the chairmanship. The zoning board is reviewing any size issues. The sign will resemble a sign from the 1890s period and will set an example for other downtown facades. The board approved the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness for the Tides Institute sign as presented.

Consideration of plantings by the Vortex sculpture. Action was postponed because there was no one present to make the request.

Updated zoning ordinances were distributed.

The Berman mall sketches have been drawn up and given to Al Salleroli. He is taking it under advisement.

The board signed the approved Certificate of Appropriateness for the windows at The Quoddy Tides.

Jean Schild will point out discrepancies with the local tax map as it compares to the Local Historic District to Robert Scott.

John Melby requested that the board consider developing an informational letter to owners who want to get their residence in the Local Historic District. He will develop a draft application form.
