You are hereby required in the name of the City of Eastport to notify and warn the Inhabitants of Ward 1 of the City of Eastport qualified to vote for Municipal Officers to assemble at the Polling Place on Monday, August 9th, 2010 at Two OCLOCK in the afternoon, then and there to give in their votes for:

1. Do you favor approving the Eastport School Budget for the upcoming school year that was approved by the Eastport School Board at its budget meeting and the Eastport City Council at its budget meeting?"

NOTE: Due to budget delays caused by the AOS consolidation mandated by the State failure to pass the school budget could have a significant negative financial impact upon the City of Eastport.

2. Second, to repeal the school budget referendum process: Do you wish to continue with the budget validation referendum process for the City of Eastport School Department for an additional three years?

NOTE: A "No" vote will discontinue the school budget referendum for at least three years. The City believes this will save a significant amount of time and money for the City if the time consuming and costly referendum process eliminated. The referendum process is considered unnecessary as public input will still remain a part of the process through the school board meetings, budget committee meetings, and various other public participation forums. This referendum was not required until recently when it became mandated by the State. The school budget would still be presented and reviewed by the residents of Eastport at the budget public hearing and would still be approved by City Council as a checks and balances.

A "Yes" vote will require the City of Eastport to continue to conduct a referendum to validate its annual school budget for the next three years.


3. Do you favor the City requesting that the Passamaquoddy Water District remove Flouride from the Eastport Water supply in a cost saving measure.

The polls will be open at Two O'clock in the afternoon and will be closed at Five O'clock in the afternoon. The Registrar of Voters will be in session from 8:00 to 4:00 at the City Hall. At the corner of High and Boynton Sts. on Friday, August.6th, 2010 and at the Polls on Monday, August 9th, 2010 for the purpose set forth in the Statutes in such cases made and provided affecting voting lists of qualified voters.


HEREOF, FAIL NOT and have you then and there this Warrant with your doings thereon.
